Cornelius' Vision:

- 10:1-2 — At Caesarea — Cornelius — a centurion — God-fearing...
- 10:3 — ...a vision. He distinctly saw an angel of God...
- 10:5 — "...bring back a man named Simon who is called Peter. He is staying with Simon the tanner..."

Peter's Vision:

- 10:13-14 — "Get up, Peter. Kill and eat."
"Surely not, Lord!" Peter replied.
- 10:15 — "Do not call anything impure that God has made clean."
- 10:16 — This happened three times...
- 10:19 — ...the Spirit said to him, "Simon, three men are looking for you."
- 10:22 — "...ask you to come to his house so that he could hear what you have to say."

At Cornelius' house:

- 10:28 — "...it is against our law for a Jew to associate with or visit a Gentile."
- 10:28 — "God has shown me that I should not call anyone impure or unclean."
- 10:34-35 — "I now realize how true it is that God does not show favoritism but accepts from every nation the one who fears him and does what is right."
- 10:35-43 — (Peter told the story of the Messiah)
- 10:45 — The circumcised believers who had come with Peter were astonished that the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out even on Gentiles.
