#### ACTS 1:3-6

After his suffering, he presented himself to them and gave many convincing proofs that he was alive. He appeared to them over a period of **forty days** and spoke about the <u>kingdom</u> <u>of God</u>. <sup>4</sup> On one occasion, while he was eating with them, he gave them this command: "Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait for the gift my Father promised, which you have heard me speak about. <sup>5</sup> For John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit." <sup>6</sup> Then they gathered around him and asked him, "Lord, are you at this time going to restore the <u>kingdom</u> to Israel?
