- Why do you think it was so critical that the believers pray to the "Sovereign Lord" here? Why is it so important that you recognize the "Sovereign Lord" in the events of your life?
- What impresses you about the believers' prayer life in this story (and how can you apply it to your prayer life)?
 - Their faith?
 - Their desire for boldness?
 - Their confidence in God's power?
 - The end results?

When in your own life have you depended on God totally, with no other recourse, and seen him work through the situation? (10 minutes)

Look carefully at Philippians 4:7-8, Philippians 4:12-13, and 2 Corinthians 5:7. As time permits, discuss each of these passages. (15 minutes)

- Do you know how to live this way?
- Why is this kind of prayer lifestyle so important in the Koinonia/fellowship of our church?

Discuss the practical issues of a prayer life, giving help on how to develop a prayer life for each person in the group. (5 minutes)
