Proverbs 21:1-3

- ¹ The king's heart is like channels of water in the hand of the LORD; He turns it wherever He pleases.
- Your anatomy (the way God designed you) has a hidden inner world—your heart—that is compared to an underground spring: it flows up from the depths, brings up what was hidden inside, and is the source of your creative or destructive activity in the world.
- Your inner world is not hidden from God, and he can reach in and direct the flow.
 - ² Every person's way is right in his own eyes, but the LORD examines the hearts.
- Until you act, the contents of your heart remain a secret to the outside world.
 - ³ To do righteousness and justice Is preferred by the LORD more than sacrifice.
- Acting deceptively cannot fool God because he can see the contents of your heart.
