

Draw a picture of someone who is royal—someone who is recognized by the world as very special.



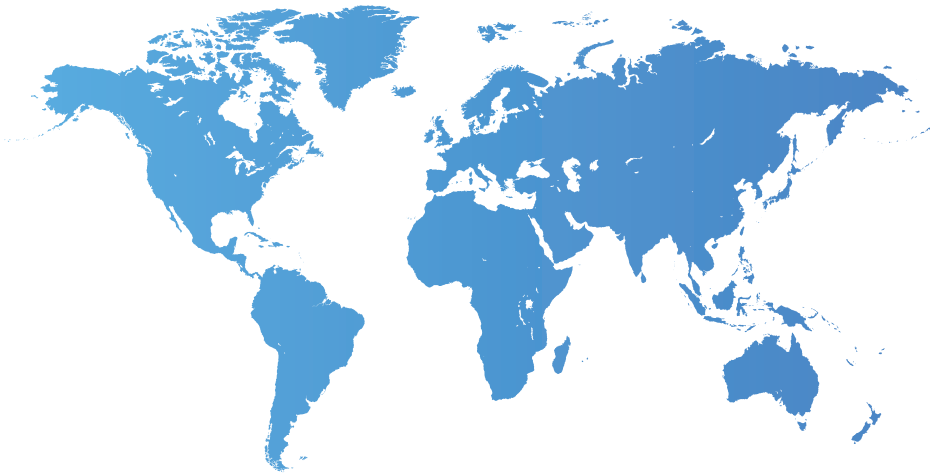
Did you know that when you are part of **God's Church** (his **Ekklesia**), YOU are someone who is royal, special, and chosen by God?

ἐκκλησία

These letters are not familiar to you because they are Greek. In English we spell the word **Ekklesia** — but can you write it in Greek?

The word **Ekklesia** is important not only because the New Testament was originally written in the Greek language, but because **Ekklesia** is the word the Bible uses to describe the **Church**.
