Digging Deeper

(for group examination and conversation, and for individual reflection)

- 1 Peter 2:9-12. Reflect on what it means when it says we are a "chosen people" and a "royal priesthood."
 - Why is this so important for us to live out as members of His Church?

Discuss how erosion in the Church can occur. Talk through each of the points, making sure we are all on the same page of understanding the danger of each of these. (25 minutes)
