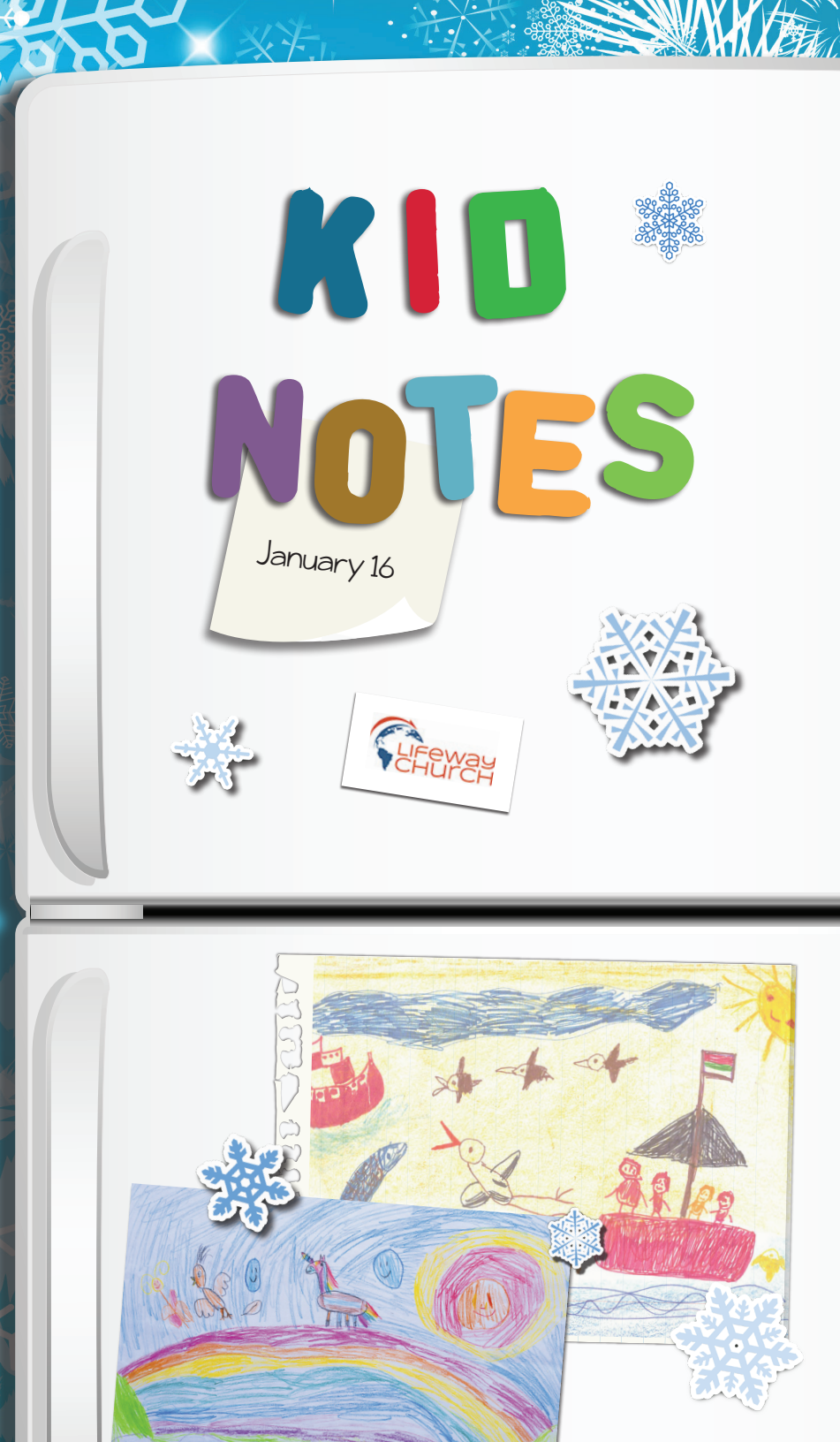


- What would you like to do for a living when you grow up?
