Acts 15:28-29 "It seemed good to the Holy Spirit and to us not to burden you with anything beyond the following requirements: ²⁹ You are to abstain from **food sacrificed to idols**, from blood, from the meat of strangled animals and from **sexual immorality**. You will do well to avoid these things."

1 Corinthians 6:18-20 (NIV) *Flee from sexual immorality.* All other sins a person commits are outside the body, but whoever sins sexually, sins against their own body. ¹⁹ Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; ²⁰ you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your bodies.

Digging Deeper

(for group study and conversation, and for personal reflection)

READ THIS ALOUD TO THE GROUP, then discuss the implications. (10 minutes)

Today's subject of sexual immorality is one of the most prevalent topics in our society. We see it, hear about it, watch it, think about it, and are confronted with it almost non-stop. It has become a "religion" in our world. At the same time, it is one that is so rarely dealt with in clarity and maturity, with care and with God's truth. Sex destroys more homes, careers and lives, and deadens more souls, than just about any other issue WHEN it is lived out in an immoral way. The deadly consequences of sexual abuse are some of the most painful issues that many of us deal with. For today, let's not get caught up in the knee-jerk reaction of shaking our fingers and blaming the world for all its ills. Next week, we will deal with how to react to our society. But for today, we would do well to first react to how each of us deals with **sexual immorality in our own lives** and in our Church, His **Body**, His **Ekklesia**.

As a group, spend time walking through the ways to personally and corporately navigate this painful issue. Read the verses provided, and think through other verses. *(30 minutes)*

- Discuss the practice of **lordship**.
- Discuss the practice of **fleeing**.
- Discuss the practice of adapting the **cultural lifestyles** around us into our own personal habits.
- Discuss the point made about distinguishing **tolerance** from patience and repentance.
- Discuss how we can find and live under the gospel of grace.

As a group, talk about the best ways to help families with children navigate this issue as we raise children up in the Lord. (10 minutes)

- Spend time praying for one another around this issue.
- Spend time praying for the children in our church around this issue.
