



Acts 20:27-31

For I have not hesitated to proclaim to you the will
of and all the flock of
which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers. Be of
the church of God, which he bought with his own blood. 29 I know
that after I leave, savage will come
in among you and will not spare the $___$. 30 Even from
your own number men will arise and distort the truth in order to
draw away disciples after them. ³¹ So be on your!

you night and day with tears.
