#### Acts 20:27-31

For I have not hesitated to proclaim to you the **whole will of God.** <sup>28</sup> **Keep watch over yourselves** and all the flock of which the Holy Spirit has made you **overseers**. Be **shepherds of the church of God**, which he bought with his own blood. <sup>29</sup> I know that after I leave, **savage wolves** will come in among you and will not spare the flock. <sup>30</sup> Even from your own number men will arise and distort the truth in order to draw away disciples after them. <sup>31</sup> So **be on your guard!** Remember that for three years I never stopped warning each of you night and day with tears.

# **Digging Deeper**

(for group study and conversation, and for personal reflection)

### Focus passage: Acts 20:13-38

Take the time as a group to read through this story together. (10 minutes)

- Review and discuss the context of this narrative.
- What are some important things that jump out to you in this story?

#### **Sheep** (10 minutes)

- How does it make you feel to be called a sheep?
- **Psalm 95:7** Come, let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the LORD our Maker; for he is our God and we are the people of his pasture, the flock under his care.

To what characteristics of a sheep can you relate as a member of Christ's Ekklesia?

### **Wolves** (10 minutes)

- What are some characteristics of wolves in the forest, and how does that apply to us here?
- Review the list of "wolves" as described in this morning's teaching. What stands out to you?
- Look over Matthew 7:15-16 to see what Jesus had to say.
- What would a wolf steal from the church body?

## **Shepherds** (10 minutes)

- Read Ezekiel 34:7-10.
- To what is the Shepherd of God's people held accountable?

- List the leadership at LifeWay. Spend time praying for them in their important roles.

  - Pastoral leadership team
