## **TODAY'S FOCUS PASSAGE: EXODUS 3:1-15**

- 3:4 God called to him from within the bush, "Moses, Moses!" And Moses said, "Here I am."
- 3:5 "Take off your sandals, for the place where you are standing is holy ground."
- 3:6 "I am the God of your father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac and the God of Jacob."
- 3:6 ... Moses hid his face...
- 3:11 Moses said to God, "Who am I that I should go...?"
- 3:14 "I AM WHO I AM (YHWH) This is what you are to say to the Israelites: 'I AM has sent you."
- 3:15 "This is my name forever, the name by which I am to be remembered from generation to generation."
