THE CRUCIFIXION AND RESURRECTION– Matthew 26:36-28:10

Day 1

Read Matthew 26:36-45. What did Jesus do before he was arrested? What was Jesus praying about? Why do you think Jesus was willing to obey God, even though he didn't want to have to go to the cross?

Day 2

Read Matthew 27:45-54. What happened when Jesus died? What did the people around him say? Who do you think Jesus is?

Day 3

Read Matthew 28:1-10. What did the angels tell the women who went to Jesus' tomb? What did the women do when they saw Jesus? What is one thing you can do right now to worship Jesus?

Day 4

Read 1 John 4:10. How did God show his love to us? Why did God send Jesus to us? Why did we need Jesus to come and die for us?

Day 5

Read Romans 10:9. What does this verse say we need to do to be saved from our sins? Why is Jesus the only one who can save us? Who do you believe Jesus is? Have you decided to follow Jesus? Today, tell someone in your family what Jesus did to be our savior.
