### **QUESTIONS FOR KIDS**

- 1. What are some things a good shepherd does, that a thief cannot?
- 2. Why do sheep follow the Good Shepherd? What is the Good Shepherd willing to sacrifice for his sheep?
- 3. Who does Jesus say is the Good Shepherd? Who are his sheep?
- 4. How do praying and reading your Bible every day help you to recognize Jesus' voice? What are you doing to learn to recognize Jesus' voice?

# QUESTIONS FOR YOUTH

- 1. Who is the Good Shepherd that the passages are referring to?
- 2. What does it mean that the Good Shepherd lays down his life for his sheep?
- 3. Do you recognize the voice of the Good Shepherd?
- This week, spend time meditating on the confidence we can have knowing Jesus won't leave you.
  What difference does that fact make in your life?

#### **QUESTIONS FOR ADULTS**

- 1. How does one know the difference between the shepherd's voice and the voice of strangers?
- 2. In the story, the sheep hears only the voice of a good shepherd. What does this truth say about the Pharisees?
- 3. What does a hired hand of the sheep care about? What does a good shepherd care about?
- 4. Who are the "hired hands" in our world? How can we avoid them?
