QUESTIONS FOR KIDS



1. How is Jesus a “visible image” of God?
2. How was Jesus involved in creation when God created the universe and everything in it? How is Jesus still involved in creation?
3. How did God use Jesus to make it possible for us to have a relationship with God?
4. How important is Jesus to creation? How important is Jesus to you?
5. How would you describe Jesus to a friend at school?

QUESTIONS FOR YOUTH



1. What verse or theme sticks out to you in this passage? Why?
2. Knowing that all things are created through him and for him (v.16), how does it change the way you see the world?
3. Verse 20 shows that Jesus reconciles all things to himself. How should people respond to knowing this? (Hint: Look up 1 Corinthians 5:18)
4. Challenge: This week, spend some time looking at God’s creation and thanking him for reconciling us to himself.

QUESTIONS FOR ADULTS



1. Which word is a keyword in this passage? (Hint: Which word keeps repeating?) For what purpose does Paul keep repeating this word?
2. Name the things Paul says is the relationship between Christ and God?
3. What point was Paul trying to make in this passage?
4. Why did Paul write this passage in here? (Hint: Look at what came before Colossians 1:15)
