QUESTIONS FOR KIDS



1. What had God already created before he created people?
2. What was different and special about people, and how God made us?
3. What did God think about creation after he created people?
4. Why do you think God made people “in his image”? How much do you think God values people if he made us “in his image”?
5. How can you reflect who God is with your actions? How can you reflect who God is with your attitudes?

QUESTIONS FOR YOUTH



1. In v. 26, who is the “us” that humans are made in the image of?
2. In what ways do you see people having dominion over the earth? What does it mean to be a good steward of the earth?
3. How should we view other people knowing that we are all made in the image of God?
4. **Challenge:** Reflect on the way you see other people who are different than you and look for a way to help take care of creation.

QUESTIONS FOR ADULTS



1. Why did God create man?
2. What does the passage say what we are to do with the living things on the earth? What does this mean to you? How does the world view its relationship with the living things on the earth?
3. How does this verse change your relationship with living things on the earth?
4. How does this passage change your view of God’s relationship with us?
5. Why does the world not want to believe that man came from God?
