QUESTIONS FOR KIDS



- 1. Why did Adam and Eve choose to eat the fruit God told them not to eat?
- 2. What did they do when God came to find them after they disobeyed him? What happened when they didn't follow God's rule?
- 3. What rescue plan did God put into motion as soon as Adam and Eve disobeyed, and messed up the relationship God wanted to have with us? When have you done things your own way instead of following God's rules? How did Jesus solve your sin problem?

QUESTIONS FOR YOUTH



- 1. In this passage, we see a glimpse of hope in verse 15. Who is this verse about and why is it important?
- 2. Why was it such a big deal that Eve took of the fruit of the tree?
- 3. What are some of the results from the human rebellion?
- 4. <u>Challenge</u>: This week, think through ways that you tend to put yourself as ruler of your life. What would it look like to give those areas up to God? How would you do that?
- 5. <u>BONUS</u>: What verse is the Protoevangelium that Billy mentioned in his sermon?



- 1. Who is the woman's Seed? What does it mean to you the woman's Seed would bruise the Serpent on the head?
- 2. How do you see God putting enmity between the Serpent and the woman, and between the Serpent's Seed and the woman's Seed today?
- 3. Explain why Genesis 3:15 is God's grace to man. (Hint: what would happen if there was no Genesis 3:15? If the verse was left out in our Bibles?)
