- 1. What does God require Abram to do?
- 2. What is the promise that God gives Abram?
- 3. How are the nations of the world (including us today) blessed because of Abrams faith?
- 4. <u>Challenge</u>: Think about what step of faith God might be calling you to take. How can you trust God with where He is leading you?

QUESTIONS FOR ADULTS

- 1. Why did God choose Abram? How does this encourage you?
- 2. What does it mean to bless someone?
- 3. What made Abram decide to obey God? If you were Abram, would you do what he did?
- 4. What does it say happened in the Bible immediately before this passage? (Hint: Read Genesis 11) Why was Genesis 12 a most gracious act from God?
