2. What is the promise that God gives Abram?
3. How are the nations of the world (including us today) blessed because of Abrams faith?
4. Challenge: Think about what step of faith God might be calling you to take. How can you trust God with where He is leading you?

## QUESTIONS FOR ADULTS



1. Why did God choose Abram? How does this encourage you?
2. What does it mean to bless someone?
3. What made Abram decide to obey God? If you were Abram, would you do what he did?
4. What does it say happened in the Bible immediately before this passage? (Hint: Read Genesis 11)  
Why was Genesis 12 a most gracious act from God?
