- 4. <u>Challenge</u>: List out a few of the things that you are thankful for, and try to think of both good and hard things that you can thank God for.

### **QUESTIONS FOR ADULTS**

- 1. Why was Paul talking about the unbelievers here in Romans 1? (Hint: What came before v.18?)
- 2. Towards what or towards whom did Paul say God unleashed his wrath?
- 3. Paul said God's invisible attributes were understood through "what has been made". What were some of the things Paul was thinking "that has been made"?
- 4. According to God, what can you and I assume from people who know him?
