QUESTIONS FOR KIDS

2. What happens to our hearts and thoughts when we don't give praise and thanks to God?
3. What are some of the things that you have seen Jesus do that you can praise him for?
4. What are some things you are thankful for right now?

QUESTIONS FOR YOUTH



Read Romans 1:21.

1. In context, who do you think this verse is referring to?
2. What does it mean to glorify and give thanks to God? What things are we supposed to thank God for?
3. According to the verse, what is the outcome of not glorifying and thanking God for all things?
4. Challenge: List out a few of the things that you are thankful for, and try to think of both good and hard things that you can thank God for.

QUESTIONS FOR ADULTS



1. Why was Paul talking about the unbelievers here in Romans 1? (Hint: What came before v.18?)
2. Towards what or towards whom did Paul say God unleashed his wrath?
3. Paul said God's invisible attributes were understood through "what has been made". What were some of the things Paul was thinking "that has been made"?
4. According to God, what can you and I assume from people who know him?
