#### **MEMORY VERSE**

### **QUESTIONS FOR KIDS**



- 1. Who does God promise will come to us? What will his names be? Who are these verses talking about?
- 2. Why do you think Jesus, who is God, chose to first come to us as a little baby?
- 3. Why do you think God chose to become a human like us?

### **QUESTIONS FOR YOUTH**



- 1. Who is this passage referring to? Who is the son?
- 2. Why is it important that those in darkness have seen a light? What does the light signify?
- 3. What are some the characteristics of the new kingdom that is led by this child?
- 4. Challenge: Memorize Isaiah 9:6-7.

## **QUESTIONS FOR ADULTS**



- 1. In light of the threat from the Assyrian army, what things do you think Judah prayed to God for in those days?
- 2. Everyone loves to receive birth announcements from a family member or a friend. Name some ways the birth announcement in Isaiah 9 is different from other birth announcements.
- 3. If you were right there listening to the birth announcement in the days of Isaiah, what would you have heard? How would you have understood, "Everlasting Father"?
- 4. Christians have traditionally linked Isaiah 9:6–7 to the birth of our Messiah in the NT. Do you agree? Why or why not?
