QUESTIONS FOR KIDS



1. Hundreds of years before Jesus was born, these verses told what would happen to him. What do you think “transgressions” and “iniquities” are?
2. If Jesus was born to be the King of Kings, why would he let himself be crushed for you and me?
3. How did Jesus’ suffering bring us peace?
4. When do you feel Jesus’ peace?

QUESTIONS FOR YOUTH



1. Why do you think v. 2 talks about Jesus not having beauty or majesty?
2. Why did we need someone to take our punishment? (Look at verse 5-6, 11).
3. What thoughts come to your mind when you think about the fact that Jesus was killed specifically for you?
4. Challenge: Memorize Isaiah 53:5

QUESTIONS FOR ADULTS



1. Was there a time you suffered for the wicked and for the wicked to be declared innocent? How did that make you feel?
2. Do you agree Isaiah 53 was referencing the Christ? Why or why not? Where in the New Testament does it reference Isaiah 53? (Answer: Acts 8)
3. How would you feel if the Messiah came as a lofty king instead of a suffering servant? How did the fact that the Messiah came as a Suffering Servant, and not some lofty king, change you?
