## JOHN 2:1-11

### **QUESTIONS FOR KIDS**

- 1. What happened at the wedding in Cana?
- 2. What did Jesus' mom tell the servants? What did Jesus tell the servants to do?
- 3. When the leader of the celebration took a sip of the drink, what did he think about it?
- 4. Why do you think Jesus chose to help?
- 5. Why do you think Jesus made a drink that was the best drink of the night, instead of a cheaper, not so great drink?
- 6. What type of stuff do you ask Jesus for help with?
  - spiritual stuff (reading and understanding the Bible, praying, memorizing scripture)
  - social stuff (help with friends and family, stuff happening in your community)
  - emotional stuff (feeling glad, sad, frustrated, lonely, worried joyful, etc...)
  - physical stuff (injuries, illnesses, health, physical strength, physical activities like sports)
  - intellectual stuff (understanding things in school, or gaining new knowledge and skills)
  - Other stuff
- 7. What kind of stuff does Jesus want to help you with?
- 8. What is one thing you are dealing with right now that you will ask Jesus help with?

# QUESTIONS FOR YOUTH

- 1. Why did Jesus say, "My hour has not yet come"?
- 2. What does the text say the outcome of this miracle was? (John 2:11)
- 3. How does knowing that God does miracles impact your view of him?
- 4. <u>Challenge</u>: Look for a way God has moved in your own life. Think of how you can glorify him in light of it.

#### **QUESTIONS FOR ADULTS**

- 1. Please explain, "Woman, what does that have to do with us?"
- 2. Why do you suppose Jesus performed the sign even though he said his hour had not yet come? Do you feel he was disobedient to the Father?
- 3. For what purpose did Jesus perform this sign?
- 4. If you were one of the disciples, did what happen at Cana make you believe in Jesus? Why or why not?
