QUESTIONS FOR KIDS



- 1. In our story this Sunday, we saw two pictures of Jesus. In the first picture, what did Jesus ask Philip when he saw the crowd? What did Andrew bring to Jesus? What did Jesus do with the loaves and fish? How much food was left over when he was done? What did the people in the crowd think about who Jesus was?
- 2. In the second picture, what did the disciples decide to do while Jesus was up on the mountain side? How did Jesus catch up with them? What do you think the disciples thought about Jesus when he got into the boat? What did you learn about who Jesus is from what Jesus did in these two stories?

QUESTIONS FOR YOUTH



- 1. What is the miracle that Jesus performed here?
- 2. Why do you think Jesus asked Philip the question in verse 5?
- 3. Why did the people want to make Jesus the king by force?
- <u>Challenge</u>: Meditate this week on who Jesus is as opposed to who culture tries to say he is.

QUESTIONS FOR ADULTS

- 1. What did the Bible say was the reason a crowd followed Jesus? How does this play into the rest of the story?
- 2. What was the significance of the leftover fragments? (Hint: What would the story be missing if there were no leftovers?)
- 3. To what conclusion did the crowd reach after they saw the sign?
- 4. Why is this story in our Bibles? Was there something specific Jesus wished to teach the crowd that day? What was it?
