### QUESTIONS FOR KIDS



1. What does Jesus call himself?
2. What does Jesus promise if we choose to follow him?
3. Why didn't the religious leaders believe Jesus?
4. Why is it okay to trust Jesus and what he tells us?
5. Where can you look to find out who Jesus says he is?
6. How have you shown Jesus that you believe he is who he says he is?

### QUESTIONS FOR YOUTH



1. Can you think of a time that you were walking down a path when it was dark? What was difficult about that?
2. How do you think that relates to spiritual darkness?
3. How would you describe what it means to put your faith in Jesus?
4. Challenge: This week, share with a friend what it means to have faith in Jesus.

### QUESTIONS FOR ADULTS



1. What is the reason Jesus said, seemingly out of the blue, he was the Light of the world? Does the context give you any hint?
2. Where else in John does it appear again that Jesus is the Light of the world? (Hint: John 9) What can we learn from that verse?
3. Who else in the Bible is also Light of the world? (Hint: Matthew 5) Do you think there is a connection between Matthew 5 and our passage? How are they connected?
4. If Jesus never said he was the Light of the world, would you and I be missing something? What is it?
