### QUESTIONS FOR KIDS



1. What does it mean to “walk” in the truth, or love, or obedience? If we just say we follow Jesus, is that enough?
2. Why does Jesus want us to follow him with our actions and attitudes?
3. Can you name 5 people Jesus wants you to love? What does it look like to love them the way Jesus commands you to?
4. Is everyone easy to love? What can you do to love people who are hard to love?

### QUESTIONS FOR YOUTH



1. Do you get excited when you hear about someone else’s faith? Can you remember a time?
2. What are some ways that you can grow in what you know?
3. Are there areas in your life where you are walking disobediently? How can you start to walk in truth and love?
4. How can you let what you believe impact how you behave?

### QUESTIONS FOR ADULTS



1. What does it mean to you to “walk in truth”? Where else in the Bible did John say he was glad to hear children walking in the truth? (Hint: 3 John) What is the significance of this?
2. According to John, what is love? Inside John’s mind, what sort of things was he thinking when he thought about the Father’s commandments?
3. Why do you think John felt it was necessary to remind the lady to love one another right at the beginning of his letter?
