QUESTIONS FOR KIDS



1. How old do you have to be to start learning God's wisdom?
2. Who should we trust with everything?
3. What happens when we seek God's will? Why can't we just rely on ourselves and what we think is right?
4. What can you do to seek God's will?
5. What is something you can trust God with this week? What will you do this week to seek God's will?

QUESTIONS FOR YOUTH



1. Why do you think keeping the commands of the proverbs adds to a long life and peace?
2. What does it look like for you to bind these words to your heart?
3. Are there ways that you are striving to be wise in your own eyes? How can you turn from that to a humble heart?
4. Challenge: Memorize Proverbs 3:5 this week.

QUESTIONS FOR ADULTS



1. What does Solomon mean by kindness (v.3)? What does he mean by truth (v.3)? Of all the virtues in the world, Solomon chose to say we must not abandon these two things?
2. How does one know if he is trusting in the Lord with all his heart? For example, if one were considering a career change, no matter if he changed career or remained in the current career, how could he tell in the end if he had trusted in the Lord or not trusted in the Lord?
3. What does it mean to acknowledge the Lord (v.6)?
4. What does it mean to you the Lord will make our paths straight? Please describe a time when you trusted in the Lord with all your heart, and he made your paths straight.
