QUESTIONS FOR KIDS



1. What does “integrity” mean?
2. How does following Jesus help us to know the right thing to do? Why is it important to always do the right thing?
3. Can you think of a time when you or someone you know acted with integrity? Is it always easy to act with integrity? Why or why not?
4. What happens when we don’t act with integrity? When we mess up, how can we still act with integrity?

QUESTIONS FOR YOUTH



1. Which proverb stood out to you the most? Why?
2. Did you notice a general theme that all of the proverbs spoke to?
3. How would you explain integrity?
4. How does integrity impact our actions?
